Following the government advice to limit non-essential travel and avoid office, pubs and social gatherings; temporary changes to bus services in Cambridgeshire are being introduced by Stagecoach from **Monday 30th March** following new government advice around social contact and non-essential travel to help combat the coronavirus.

We have made the difficult decision to postpone the launch of our enhanced Busway service until further notice.

An enhanced Sunday timetable will operate Monday-Saturday until further notice. Due to timetable changes, the R will also be suspended until further notice.

Busway services will be returning to their normal routes on the track from 30th March and will no longer be diverted via Histon.

Sunday will remain unchanged.

H service will remain unchanged.
